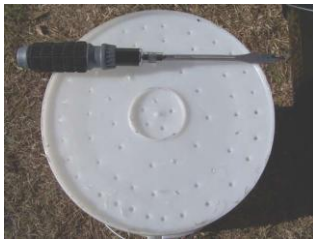


## Non Electric Laundry Press

This process takes wet, clean clothes, and presses the water from them before hanging them on the line to dry. This is a lot easier than a ringer, and easier on the clothes (and operator) You will need 3 buckets, one lid, and a hand or electric drill with a ¼" and ½" wood bits. ### Step 1

**Drill the strainer bucket** making a series of ¼" holes in the bottom of one of the buckets. Your wet clothes will go in this bucket.



### Step 2

**Drill the collector bucket:** Take the second bucket and drill three 1/2" holes in the lower side, spread around the outside of the bucket. The water from the strainer collects in this bucket, and drains out these holes.

### Step 3

The ram (seat) bucket the last bucket is the seat. Put the lid on the bucket. Drill no holes. You can use this bucket to store your detergents and accessories like clothes line and clothes pins.



### Step 4

#### Assemble the system

Insert the strainer bucket into the collector bucket. Put the wet clothes in the strainer bucket. Insert the seat bucket into the strainer bucket. Sit on the seat until no more water comes out of the hole in the collector bucket. Hang clothes on line to dry
